







Announcement of a Literary Competition

The Cultural Association Energheia of Matera (Italy) and József Attila Circle Literary Association of Young Writers – JAK (Hungary) in cooperation with the Department of Languages, Literatures and Intercultural Studies - University of Florence and the Hungarian Academy Rome with the support of Basilicata Region are proud to announce the Literary Prize "Energheia Hungary - 2017".

- 1. Writers, between the age of 18-30, are allowed to participate in the competition with no more than one unpublished short story, written in Hungarian, on a freely chosen subject, of no more than five pages (20,000 caracters, including spaces).
- 2. The story must be sent before 11th June 2017 to: $jak@jozsefattilakor.hu\ {\it and}\ energheia.unifi@gmail.com:$
- Attach the text to the e-mail, use a pen name (or nickname),
- Attach **another document** with the author's name. age, address (telephone number and e-mail),
- Please use the subject line "Energheia 2017". Each competitor may propose only one text. We will not accept submissions past the deadline.
- 3. An International Committee appointed by the organizers will read and evaluate the stories to indicate the best 3 ones to be submitted to the Italian Jury's final judge-ment. The organizer reserves the right of preselection. The final winner among the 3 competitors will be the chosen by the Jury in Italy.

The name of the finalists and of the winner will be announced before the 31st July. The 3 finalist authors will have the opportunity to be guest of the Hungarian Academy in Rome for a week. The final winner of the Prize may attend the closing ceremony of the European Literary Prize Energheia, September 16, 2017 as a guest of the Energheia Association in Matera.

- 4. The Organizers reserve the exclusive right to publish the short stories by the 3 finalists in Hungarian, in Italian translation and possibly in all the languages of the countries participating in European Literary Prize Energheia 2017 in print and/or digital form as an open access publication, no royalty, guaranteed the integrity of the texts.
- 5. It is up for the organizers of the competition to decide about anything which is not included in the present regulations.
